CENTENNIAL CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

People and places are the heartbeat of a community. Each passing day is a reminder that our community is changing and growing and often, the history is forgotten.

The Vero Beach Centennial is the perfect time to commemorate the City's history. In recognition of this banner year, the City of Vero Beach Centennial Committee is starting the "Centennial Certificate" program. The award aims to recognize and acknowledge those persons (or ancestors) who resided within today's City of Vero Beach city limits 100 years ago or earlier. The committee will also award a certificate to an existing business, organization or building that was either established or built in 1920 and prior (within current city limits).

In an effort to provide greater recognition for the City's local history, a second certificate, known as the "Boomers" certificate will be offered with the same criteria as above, except the qualifying years will be between 1920 – 1945 for persons (or ancestors) and 1921-1945 for businesses, organizations and buildings.

To qualify, a signed official application must be submitted along with proof the criteria has been met for at least one of the categories for each certificate type.

Upon approval of your application, each honoree will receive a complimentary certificate during a special public presentation to take place on September 20th, 2019 at the Vero Beach Woman's Club building from 5:30pm to 7pm.
